**AGREED ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF COLLECTIVE ACTION
SETTLEMENT AND ISSUANCE OF NOTICE TO THE SETTLEMENT COLLECTIVE AND
TO DISMISS ACTION WITH PREJUDICE**

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Order Approving Collective Action Settlement and Issuance of Notice to the Settlement Collective and to Dismiss Action with Prejudice ("Motion"). Having reviewed the Motion and all accompanying papers, and the Court being otherwise fully advised, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

Plaintiff's Motion is **GRANTED**. The Court finds that the settlement reached by the Parties in this FLSA action is fair, reasonable, and just.

1. The Settlement Agreement is APPROVED and the case is certified as a collective action pursuant to Section 216(b) of the Fair Labor Standards Act for settlement purposes only. The Settlement Claims Administrator is authorized to send notice and issue payments pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement.
2. All Potential Opt-In Plaintiffs who timely return properly completed and executed Consent to Join Settlement as a Plaintiff, Release, and Claim Form ("Claim Form") shall be bound by the Release by Qualified Claimants as set forth in the Claim Form and Section IV.A of the Settlement Agreement, which is effective as of the date of this Order.

3. This Action is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
4. Without affecting the finality of this Order in any way, this Court RETAINS JURISDICTION over the Parties to this action for the purpose of the administration and enforcement of the Settlement until the conclusion of the settlement administration process.
5. The case is closed and all pending motions are denied as moot.
